Tim is a Lecturer within the School of Information Technology at Deakin University, teaching units on computer graphics, artificial intelligence, mathematics and programming.

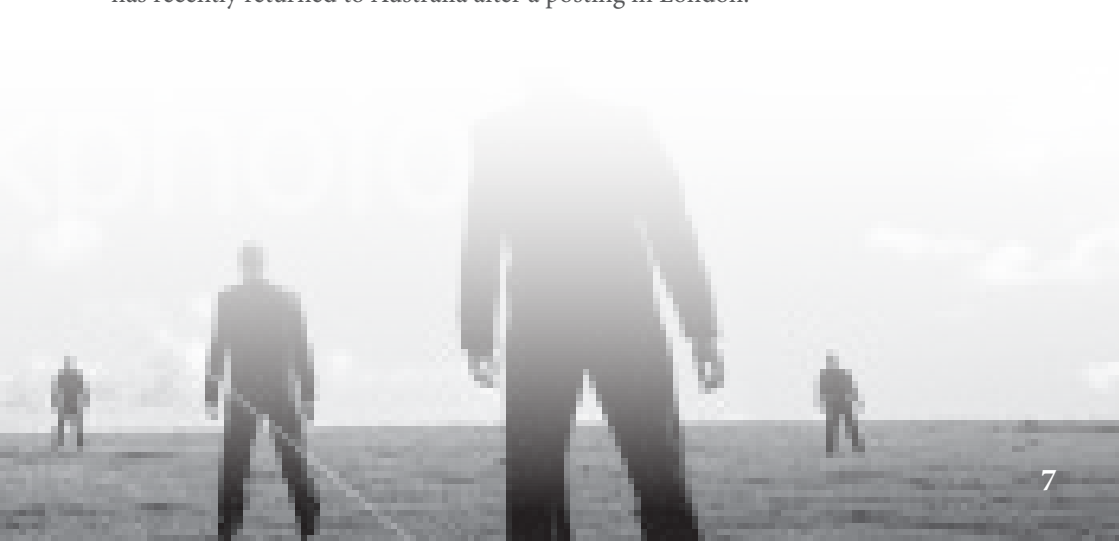
INVESTMENT AND WEALTH MANAGEMENT

Jarrod is the Apprenticeship Officer with Master Builders Victoria.

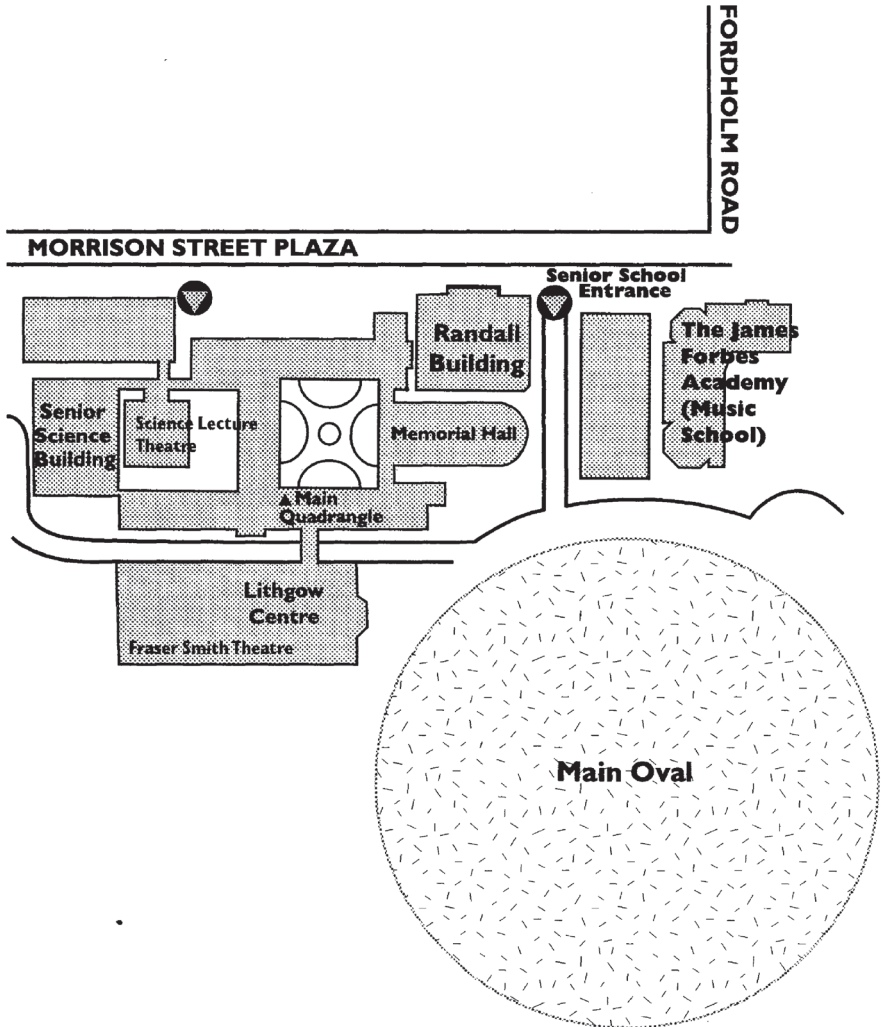
