

Myki information for children aged 5 to 18

Primary and secondary school students aged 5 to 18 can travel on a Child myki. Children aged 16 and under don't need to carry proof of age.



Where to buy

- Hundreds of shops including all 7-Elevens within the myki boundary
- myki machines at selected train stations, tram stops and bus interchanges
- Premium station ticket offices
- PTV Hubs

How much

A Child myki card costs \$3:

- Children aged 5 to 18 (including children from other states and international visitors).
- 17 and 18 year olds are required to carry proof of age card or other concession entitlement to travel on a child myki.
- Children aged 4 and under travel free and don't need a myki

How to buy

myki Money – Students can load money onto their myki and it will calculate the lowest fare based on where they travel.

myki Pass – Students can buy consecutive days of travel. They can choose where they'll be travelling and how many days they need. myki Pass can be purchased for 7 days or anywhere between 28 and 365 days.

Auto top up

Students have the option to set auto top up on their myki. Students must:

1. Ensure their myki is registered
2. Login to their account
3. Choose a minimum balance

Select their auto top up amount (e.g. when their myki Money balance reaches \$10, they could top up with \$25).
